Isaiah 30:(8-14)**15-17 NIV** (8 Go now, write it on a tablet for them, inscribe it on a scroll, that for the days to come it may be an everlasting witness. 9 These are rebellious people, deceitful children, children unwilling to listen to the LORD's instruction. 10 They say to the seers, "See no more visions!" and to the prophets, "Give us no more visions of what is right! C: I do so believe.

P: Truly you should believe, for Holy Scripture declares: "God so loved the world that He gave His only-begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him should **not** perish, but have everlasting life. / Do you **promise** that by the power of the Holy Spirit you will amend your sinful life?

C: I do so promise.

P: Truly you should promise, for Christ our Lord says: "Let your light shine before men that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven." / Finally, Do you believe that through me, a called servant of God, you will receive the forgiveness of all your sins?
