

THE ADVENT WREATH

The Advent wreath is a contribution of the German and Scandinavian traditions. It developed out of the simple use of an evergreen spray of fir, spruce, balsam, or pine placed near the hearth. The wreath is plain, without any ornamentation of ribbon or bow. The evergreen of the wreath represents the life that is found in Christ. The greens have come from the out-of-doors where nature has begun its winter sleep. Midst the drabness of nature the evergreen branch symbolizes the continuation of life. In the home it is placed on a central table. In the church it is usually suspended above the altar or set on a pedestal resting on the floor.

The Advent candles are arranged with the spray. Candles have been used for centuries as the symbol of light. The light reminds us of Christ, the Light of the world, so it is not at all strange that the Christian church has given the candle a prominent place in the observance of Advent.

It is the living light, the living flame that gives the candle its meaning, for the Gospel Light of Christ is itself a living power. This is what makes it more symbolic than artificial lights.

Jesus is the Light that broke forth on the world on that first Christmas when He was born as Prince of Peace. He is the light that gradually penetrated into all the world. The traditional act of lighting one more candle each week of Advent tells of the increasingly brighter light of His Coming, and leads gradually to the blaze of light at the dawning of Christmas.

1st Sunday in Advent - Jeremiah 33:14-16; Isaiah 9:1-2

Christ the Branch of Righteousness is promised.

The Prophecy Candle honors those who spoke His promises

2nd Sunday in Advent - Micah 4:1-7, 5:2

Christ will establish His Kingdom of Grace.

The Bethlehem Candle symbolizes the preparations made for Him.

3rd Sunday in Advent - Malachi 3:1-6; Luke 2:20

Christ shall purify His people.

The Shepherds' Candle honors the first to spread the good news.

4th Sunday in Advent - Isaiah 40:1-8; Luke 2:13-14

Christ shall comfort His people.

The Angels' Candle celebrates the joy of God's grace to mankind

THE DIVINE SERVICE

We call our regular Worship the "Divine Service" because it is the service of God to man. This can hardly be more true than in today's service than when we celebrate God's coming into Humanity in the Person of Jesus Christ. He is True God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true man, conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary to substitute for all men, women, and children and to atone for our sins.

The service follows the pattern of the Lutheran "Chorale" service, in which the main parts of the service take the form of hymns and readings.

INTRODUCTION In Galatians 4 St. Paul said: "When the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons" (v.4-5). Or, to use our Advent Theme of "God's Family Tree," now the tree comes to full fruition, now God PRESENTS His Family Tree to you. The Seed promised to Eve is delivered through the blessed Virgin Mary. Abraham could only trust the Promise of this Seed, but tonight we see that Promise fulfilled and the world blessed. And in this little Baby, lying in a manger, God restores the peace and prosperity that King David and his kingdom of Israel merely tasted. Tonight, dear friends and fellow saints, you see that Jesus Christ, God in the flesh, is your tree of life.

The PLANTED Tree PRESENTED:

SEPARATION Adam and Eve separated themselves and all of humanity from the Tree of Life with God. That's why you and I have heartaches and frustrations, the broken lives and frantic pace of life. We are separated from God, and we try to play gods ourselves. We think that if we just try harder, we can attain the perfect peace that knows no end. But, as we see in all of our Christmas planning and partying, trying harder and harder only leads to more headaches and worries.

IT'S HERE

But tonight God's Family PLANTED Tree becomes His Family Tree PRESENTED for all to see. Tonight we see how God answers our frantic, frenzied, frazzled attempts to live without Him. He sends His own Son into the flesh. This little Child, wrapped in swaddling cloths, crushes the head of the satanic serpent and once again unites heaven and earth. As the angels sang to the shepherds, "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, goodwill toward men" (Luke 2:14). This little Infant comes to graft you back into life with God, and in the Blood that runs through His tiny arteries and veins God gives you His Heavenly peace and goodwill here on earth.

The PROMISED Tree PRESENTED:

WE DOUBT TOO When **Abraham doubted God's Promise to bless the world** through his family line, he shows us what's in our hearts
and minds as well. We see the mess of our lives and the broken pieces
of our shattered dreams, and we doubt that God is good or that He loves
us and takes care of us. Like Abraham, we try to fabricate our own
fulfillments to God's promises. "God wants me to be happy," we say, "so
He must want me to healthy, wealthy, and wise."

AWAY WITH (ALL) DOUBTS But tonight God's Family Tree PROMISED becomes His Family Tree **presented for all to see**. Tonight we see God's answer to our empty promises and our hollow fulfillments.

God promised Abraham that he would be a Blessing to all nations. In the "Little Town of Bethlehem" God's promised Blessing came true. As the angel comforted the frightened shepherds, God also comforts you: "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord." (Luke 2:10–11). This tiny Baby gives new confidence in God's Promises by forgiving all doubts.

The PRUNED Tree PRESENTED:

TRUE PEACE When David rested in the peaceful kingdom that God gave him, he had merely a **foretaste of the peace that Christ would bring**. And Israel found out that earthly peace does not last when they went astray from God and He sent them into exile. Do not look for peace and prosperity on earth. At the very least, earthly peace and prosperity pass away all too quickly, but most of the time they lure you away from trusting your God and Savior. Rather, look for peace and prosperity in the Christ Child, the Child who would grow up, go to a **Cross, suffer and die, and then Rise again** to give you **true peace** with God and His eternal riches of forgiveness and life.

SPROUT OF JESSE Tonight God's Family Tree PRUNED becomes His Family Tree **presented for all to see**. We see the Root of Jesse sprout forth for all to behold. This little Christ Child is no mere child. He is God in the flesh, "For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily" (Colossians 2:9),

and He is the One "In Whom we have Redemption through His Blood, the forgiveness of sins." (Colossians 1:14). All of God's peace and heavenly prosperity for you are wrapped up and presented to you this day in this little package, this little Christmas present of divine Flesh and Blood. "We have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Chris.t" (Romans 5:1).

CONCLUSION When you look at God's Family Tree, (The "Jesse Tree") you see God's age-old Promises fulfilled. You see God's Seed of a Savior coming to full fruition in Jesus Christ. You see yourself grafted back into life with God. The **hymn stanzas** (ELH **302,3-4**) say it well:

What mercy God showed to our race, - A plan of Rescue by His grace: In sending One from woman's seed, - The One to fill our greatest need-For on a tree uplifted high - His only Son for sin would die, Would drink the cup of scorn and dread - To crush the ancient serpent's head!

Now from that tree of Jesus' shame - Flows life eternal in His Name; For all who trust and will believe, - Salvation's living Fruit receive. And of this Fruit so pure and sweet - The Lord invites the world to eat, To find within this Cross of wood - The Tree of Life with ev'ry good.
