
John 16:23-30 In that day you will no longer ask Me anything. I tell you the truth, My Father will give you whatever you ask in My Name. 24

EASTER-6C (or PENTECOST) John 14:23-31 "HANG ON WORDS" 05.26.19 OSL

WHEN YOU LOVE SOMEONE, YOU HANG ON THEIR EVERY WORD. I remember growing up during the Vietnam war. I was too young to be drafted, but older brothers of my friends were. Some were barely eighteen years old when they were separated from the families and sent to fight. The only contact they had with home was the occasional letter. Letters long on love, but sometimes short on detail. Letters filled with the trivial details of daily life. Letters filled with phrases like, "I miss all of you very much." Families would cling to every word of those letters from their sons. Sons would cling to every word of letters from their families. THEME: WHEN YOU LOVE SOMEONE, YOU HANG ON EVERY WORD THEY SAY.

LOVE LETTER/S Think of when you **first met your spouse**, or when **you fell in love for the first time**. Every word that person said was so important. You read between the lines of his or her letters. You listened for every nuance, every turn of phrase, every pause. *You hung on every word.*

KEEP MY WORD Jesus says in our text, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Word." Now, "Keep My Word" certainly includes "Obey My Teaching," but it means much more than that. It goes without saying that anyone who loves Christ will want to obey Him. A few sentences earlier, Jesus said: "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Commandments." And His "New" Commandments aren't burdensome and heavy, like the (Ten) Commandments of Moses. These are His Commandments: that we believe in His Name and that we love one another with His love. Love and faith always go together. To love Jesus is to believe in Him, and to believe in Jesus is to love Him. And to love Him is to love one another.

...AND MORE

But Jesus pushes things a bit further in our text. He says, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Word – he will cling to My Word, guard My Word, treasure My Word." Sheep love to hear their shepherd's voice. Children love their parents' voice/s (usually). Those who love Jesus and believe in Him hang on to His every Word and treasure it in their hearts.

WORTH IT And, **Jesus' Words** are worth hanging on to. "My Words are Spirit and they are life," Jesus said. His Words are full of the Holy Spirit. They are brimming over with His life. "Lord, to whom shall we go(?)" Peter asked. "You have the Words of Eternal Life." We need look no further than the Words of Jesus for our life. Oh, we might imagine that we need to go further, or higher, or deeper than His words. Who would think that the most spiritual thing we have is words? But Jesus says, "(No) All you need are My Words. Hang on to them."

WORDS **DO** THINGS Think of what Jesus' Words **DO!** With His Words He **Baptizes**. With His Words He **Forgives**. With His Words He gives His own **Body** to eat and His own **Blood** to drink. With His Words He **creates Faith** in hardened, unbelieving hearts and fills them with His **Love**. With His Words, He **calls sinners** to Himself. With His Words He is present to bring His peace.

TWO THINGS Jesus highlights this morning: HIS PRESENCE AND HIS PEACE.

1. JESUS PROMISES HIS PRESENCE. He had told them that He was going away and they would see him no more, and yet by going away He would come to them. "I go away, and I will come to you." The disciples didn't quite get this talk of going away and coming. Jesus was speaking about His Death and Resurrection and Ascension. Soon, they would no longer see Him, but He would still come to them and be present with them, present in an even greater way than He already was with them - present with His Words and the Holy Spirit.

DAD TOO Not only Jesus, but **His Father will be present too**, because the Father and the Son are **One in Essence**. They are One God. Jesus' Words are the Father's Words. He says, "My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him."

(H.S.) HAVE ALL THREE And the Father will send Another, this "Counselor," Who is the Holy Spirit, in the Name of Jesus. You see, to **have Jesus is to have the entire Triune God** – all Three: the Father, the Son, the Holy Spirit. No matter how alone you may be in this world, no matter how isolated you may feel, you have **Jesus AND** the Father **AND** the Holy Spirit with you **at all times**.

IT'S ALL ABOUT JESUS Notice how everything revolves around Jesus. No Father without the Son. And no Holy Spirit without Jesus. He is sent in Jesus' Name. Everything centers on Jesus. Jesus is the only mediator between God and man. He is the One Who gets between us and the Father, Who touches our humanity with His Humanity, but Who touches the Father's divinity with His divinity, Who presents His sacrifice for our sin, who makes peace for us with the Father. Luther got it right (again) when he said, "I know no other God than this MAN Named Jesus."

H.S. AT WORK

The Holy Spirit draws our attention, not on or to Himself, but back to Jesus and His Words. "He will teach you all things, and bring to your mind all that I have said to you." Where God's Word is being taught truly and purely, where Jesus' Words are brought to our remembrance, there the Holy Spirit is at work. Creating and enlivening faith in Jesus. The Spirit is at work in Baptism, in the Word when you hear or read it, in the Lord's Supper, in the Holy Ministry, in other Christians when they speak the Word to you, IN YOU as you speak the Words of Jesus to others. The Spirit always comes to us through Means, and He always uses means, earthy real things like water, words, bread, wine, pastors, people. Through these the Spirit teaches us and lays the Words of Jesus on our minds and hearts so that we would trust Him and receive His presence in our lives.

HAS TO WORK

Unless the Spirit continually works faith in us, unless He opens our hearts and minds and ears, God's Word will have no impact. That's why every Sun/day we can and should pray, "Send your Holy Spirit into our hearts that He may establish in us a living faith and prepare us joyfully to remember our Redeemer and receive Him Who comes to us in His Body and Blood." And, thank God He hears and answers that prayer. Without the Holy Spirit working repentance and faith in our hearts, the Body and Blood of Christ would do us no good and could even be hazardous to our health.

OUR PRAYER That Sunday (Eucharistic) prayer is also our **daily** prayer, that God would send the Spirit in the name of His Son to establish in us a living faith that is active in love, that holds on to Christ's words and receives Him new each day.

IN BAPTISM...We received everything that Jesus died to win for us. The forgiveness of our sins. The Holy Church. Resurrection, Eternal Life, Salvation. The presence of Christ and the Father both in us and among us in the congregation. It is all in place for us, so near and close to us, to draw upon and use each and every day. It's as if God has, out of his own generosity and kindness, **deposited ten million dollars** in a bank account with our name, and said, "**Now draw on it, use it, spend it**. And don't worry how often you turn to it. There's plenty more where that came from."

DON'T BE A FOOL Now, if we **insist** on living in **despair**, as though we had nothing, as though we were **not** baptized, as though we did not have Christ or the

Father or the Holy Spirit, as though we did not have Jesus' Words of life, we have only **ourselves to blame**. It would be sheer foolishness not to withdraw from that ten million dollar bank account when you couldn't pay the bills, wouldn't it? Only a fool would reject such a gift. Now you see why **unbelief is called foolishness** in the Scriptures. And **faith is called wisdom**.

BAPTISM BANK ACCOUNT Think of Baptism as that **bottomless** bank account, or a well of fresh water that never runs dry. We have it in our possession. Now we need to put that baptismal bank account to daily use, as Luther taught in the Small Catechism. Daily confessing our sin to God, drowning all that is death and darkness and evil in us, burying it in Jesus' death, so that sin would have no dominion over us. Daily we need to pray out of our Baptism for cleansing and renewal as David did: "Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean. Wash me and I will be whiter than snow." Or, as we say or pray after the sermon each Sunday, "Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me." We need to pray each day that the Spirit would teach us all things and bring to our remembrance the Words of Jesus. He will bring to your mind Jesus' Words of forgiveness that you heard today. And, in that case, when those Words are spoken by any one of us mere mortals, they are actually **Christ's Words**. **Cling** to these Words. **Treasure** them. Guard them. They are His Words, but (because He loves you so much) He wants YOU to have them.

2. Along with His presence, JESUS ALSO PROMISES PEACE. Peace is *His legacy*: "Peace I leave with you." Peace is also His gift. "My peace I give to you." The peace He gives is an "unworldly" peace, a peace that the world cannot give. The world's peace comes through war. I guess, Jesus' peace came through war too, but it wasn't any human war. It was the war God and Jesus had *and won* over Satan! Jesus' peace comes through His wounds (His battle scars), His broken body and His shed blood. "The punishment that brought us peace was upon Him, and by His wounds we are healed." His peace holds even though the world's peace fails, though war and rumor of war is all around us, though nations are in uproar and testing their nuclear bombs, though our life here may seem to be in turmoil. Even when "all hell seems to be breaking loose" around us, we have peace with Jesus. Unshakable peace. Eternal peace. Peace that exceeds (passes all) our understanding.

FIND PEACE? Likewise, why don't we realize this peace or experience it more fully? Why don't we seem to realize that peace? Why are we always **searching for peace?** Again, we have **only ourselves to blame**. It's our sin, our unbelief cloud getting in the way of this peace of Jesus.

BEEN THERE ALL THE TIME There is nothing wrong with the Peace of Jesus or our Baptism or the Holy Spirit. IT'S US. Our sin against others and God, and the sin of others against us, have smudged the view, robbing us of peace. But the peace of Jesus is (still, always) there for you. Let Him wipe away the dust and dirt from your window, the crud that clouds your view of His peace. Let His Blood cleanse you from all unrighteousness. Let His Baptism wash you with His forgiveness. Let His Words renew and restore your life. You will discover that His Peace and His Presence have been there all along! Just like He said.

(v27) "Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid." **His Presence** and **His Peace** are yours. You have His Words. Hang on to them. *IJ'N, Amen. SDG*

For a long memory to recall those who gave the full measure of their devotion to our country and served faithfully until death in the protection of our freedom and in the defense of our land, let us pray to the Lord: **Lord, have mercy.**

For the graduates who begin a new chapter of their lives, that they may find a place and a purpose to use their gifts and employ their knowledge for the good of others, let us pray to the Lord: **Lord, have mercy.**

For the lonely, for the troubled in mind and heart, for the poor, for the homeless and for those who have lost hope and become prisoners to despair, let us pray to the Lord: **Lord, have mercy.**

For the ill, the grieving and the dying, especially for those we name with our voices *[including OSL Prayer List]* and in our hearts ... and for the grace to sustain them in their hour of need, let us pray to the Lord; **Lord**, **have mercy**.
